

WEINGUT ROBERT WEIL

Founded in 1875, Weingut Robert Weil is considered to be one of the Rheingau's younger wine estates. It is located in the heart of Kiedrich, a village first documented in the year 950. Kiedrich Turmberg and Kiedrich Gräfenberg, the estate's top vineyards, are among the finest sites in the Rheingau.

The estate cultivates 70 hectares (173 acres) of vineyards, of which 98 percent are planted with Riesling. Today, Wilhelm Weil, the great-grandson of the estate's founder, carries on the uncompromising, quality-oriented vineyard and cellar practices that have been the hallmark of the winery for four generations.

2010 WEINGUT ROBERT WEIL RIESLING TRADITION

The philosophy at Weingut Robert Weil is to combine modern ideas with the long tradition of viticulture in the Rheingau. This wine is a case in point: It's the estate's classic rendition of the traditional off-dry style that made the Rheingau famous.



The Riesling Tradition is a cuvée from parcels that neighbor the estate's top vineyard sites in Kiedrich. The deep and medium-deep soils of the vineyards consist of stony, fragmented phyllite mixed with loess and loam. The character of this Riesling, like all Robert Weil Rieslings, is defined largely by these mineral-rich soils.

2010 TASTING NOTES

The 2010 growing season in the Rheingau got off to a late start after a long, snowy winter. But beautiful, sunny weather in October brought full ripeness, long hang time and extraordinary concentration to the wines.

The 2010 Riesling Tradition has a complex, enveloping aroma of lush fruits, with a hint of sandalwood. It is full and juicy on the palate, with a spicy acid crackle and a long, tingling finish.
